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Introduction

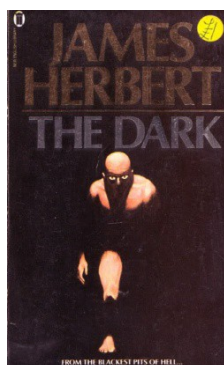
A Spiritual Battle?

Definition number 4 "a highly refined substance or fluid thought to govern vital phenomena" is a link between the other definitions and will be very pertinent going forward in this article.

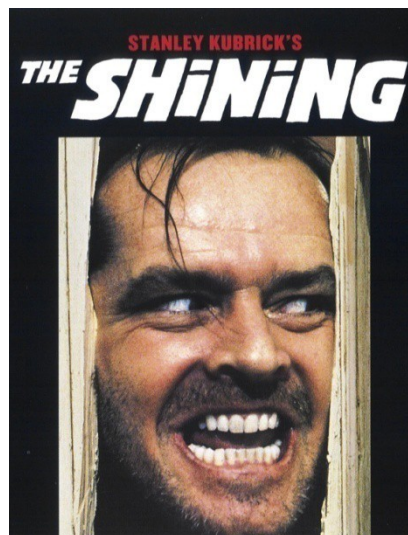

Alcohol Poisoning Deaths — United States, 2010–2012

Results: During 2010–2012, an annual average of 2,221 alcohol poisoning deaths (8.8 deaths per 1 million population) occurred among persons aged ≥15 years in the United States. Of those deaths, 1,681 (75.7%) involved adults aged 35–64 years, and 1,696 (76.4%) involved men. Although non-Hispanic whites accounted for the majority of alcohol poisoning deaths (67.5%; 1,500 deaths), the highest age-adjusted death rate was among American Indians/Alaska Natives (49.1 per 1 million). The age-adjusted rate of alcohol poisoning deaths in states ranged from 5.3 per 1 million in Alabama to 46.5 per 1 million in Alaska.

Conclusions: On average, six persons, mostly adult men, die from alcohol poisoning each day in the United States. Alcohol poisoning death rates vary substantially by state.

The findings in this analysis are subject to at least three limitations. First, alcohol-attributable deaths, including alcohol poisoning, are underreported (16–18). Second, this study was restricted to deaths in which alcohol poisoning was the underlying cause of death, and did not include deaths in which alcohol poisoning was a contributing cause of death. A previous study found that there were three times as many deaths in which alcohol poisoning was a contributing, rather than underlying cause of death. Finally, mortality data might underestimate the actual number of deaths for American Indians/Alaska Natives and certain other racial/ethnic populations (e.g., Hispanics) because of misclassification of race/ethnicity of the decedents on death certificates.

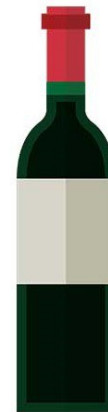

Underage drinking statistics in the USA

In 2015, 7.7 million young people ages 12–20 reported that they drank alcohol beyond “just a few sips” in the past month.

Based on data from 2006–2010, the Centres for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) estimates that, on average, alcohol is a factor in the deaths of 4,358 young people under age 21 each year.

This includes:

1,580 deaths from motor vehicle crashes

1,269 from homicides

245 from alcohol poisoning, falls, burns, and drowning

492 from suicides

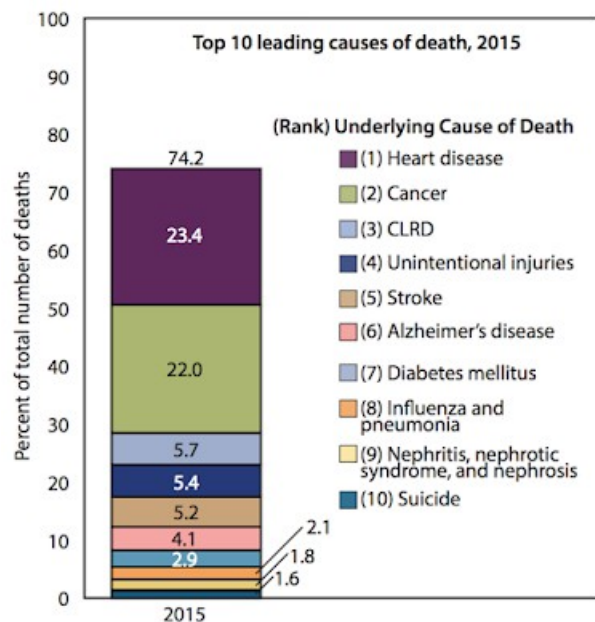

More than 15 million people struggle with an alcohol use disorder in the United States, but less than eight percent of those receive treatment.

More than 65 million Americans report binge drinking in the past month, which is more than 40 percent of the total of current alcohol users.

Alcoholism affects people from all walks of life. According to the United States Centers for Disease Control (CDC), more than **88,000 people die** from alcohol-related deaths each year in the United States.

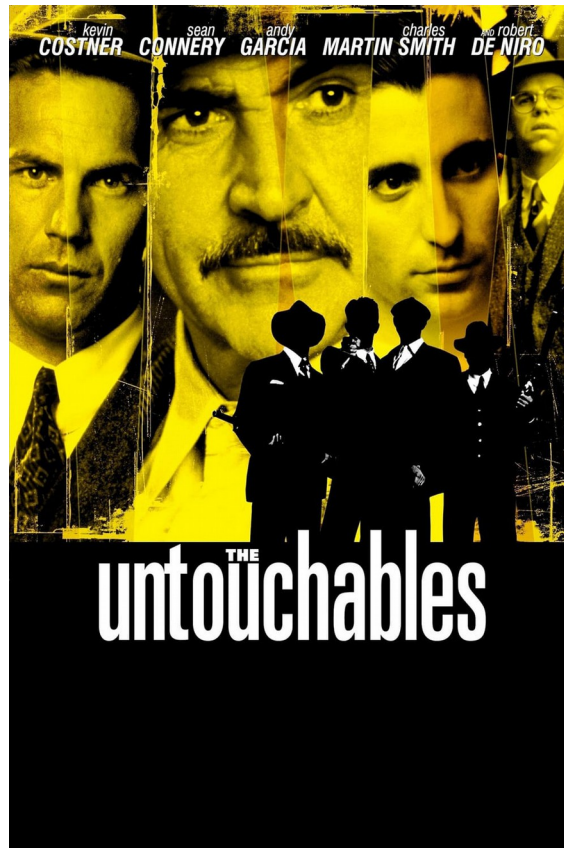
NB.

They were already trying in 1862 to drive out this type of fuel.

"In 1862 and 1864, a tax on alcohol was passed in the U.S. to pay for the Civil War, increasing the price of ethanol to over \$2.00 per gallon. A new product from petroleum, called kerosene, is taxed at 10 cents a gallon."

"In 1906, the Free Alcohol bill is passed. The USA repeals the alcohol tax under Teddy Roosevelt. At 14 cents per US gallon, corn ethanol was cheaper than gasoline at 22 cents per US gallon."

"In 1914, the Free Alcohol bill is amended again to decrease the regulatory burden and encourage alcohol fuel production in the U.S."

In 1917 Alexander Graham Bell says: "Alcohol makes a beautiful, clean and efficient fuel... Alcohol can be manufactured from corn stalks, and in fact from almost any vegetable matter capable of fermentation... We need never fear the exhaustion of our present fuel supplies so long as we can produce an annual crop of alcohol to any extent desired." _

Part Three - What is Schizophrenia?

The information below is taken from the NHS (National Health Service) official website in the UK.

Schizophrenia is a severe long-term mental health condition. It causes a range of different psychological symptoms.

Doctors often describe schizophrenia as a type of psychosis. This means the person may not always be able to distinguish their own thoughts and ideas from reality.

Symptoms of schizophrenia include:

- ***hallucinations*** – hearing or seeing things that don't exist
- ***delusions*** – unusual beliefs not based on reality
- ***muddled thoughts*** based on hallucinations or delusions
- ***changes in behaviour***

Some people think schizophrenia causes a "split personality" or violent behaviour. This is not true.

The cause of any violent behaviour is usually drug or alcohol misuse.

I have pulled out the key points below. **Hallucinations and hearing voices**

Hallucinations are where someone sees, hears, smells, tastes or feels things that don't exist outside their mind.

They're common in people with schizophrenia, and are usually experienced as hearing voices.

Hallucinations can be frightening, but there's usually an identifiable cause. For example, they can occur as a result of:

- *taking illegal drugs or alcohol*
- *a mental illness, such as schizophrenia*
- *a progressive neurological condition, such as Alzheimer's disease or Parkinson's disease*
- *loss of vision caused by a condition such as macular degeneration – this is known as Charles Bonnet syndrome*

See your GP straight away if you're experiencing hallucinations. The recommended treatment options for hallucinations will depend on the underlying cause. For example, antipsychotic medication may help with hallucinations for people living with schizophrenia.

Scary stuff and would you believe that the so called experts in this field openly admit that they do not know what causes schizophrenia, they really do not have a clue. They have identified certain triggers that aggravate the situation such as stress or drug and **alcohol abuse** but that is it. Antipsychotic medication is always the preferred treatment. This essentially in most cases retards thinking in people by reducing what has been identified as dopamine in the brain. Slowing them down to a point where even everyday tasks such as getting dressed or washing are extremely difficult. 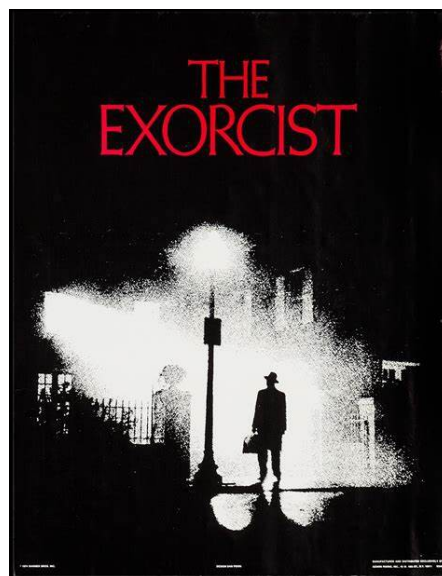

Examples in the media are many, but for most, this topic can be summed up all in one movie in particular.

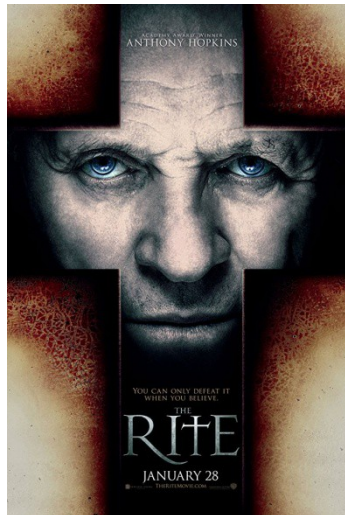

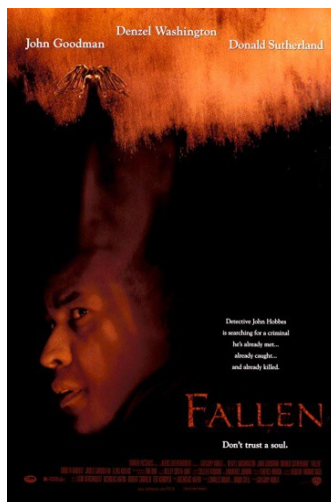

The Growing Evidence for Demonic Possession: What Should Psychiatry's Response be?

Evidence of evil spirits is voluminous and comes from many cultures, both ancient and modern. Cases from China, India, and the United States are examined and evaluated. The actual experience of spirit victims, the universality of spirit oppression, the superhuman phenomena associated with

“possession,” and the comparative success of deliverance and exorcism vs. psychiatry are considered. Potential arguments against the spirit hypothesis centre on the antecedent improbability of spirits, multiple personality disorder, and the effectiveness of medication; but these can be countered. Psychiatrists should question their materialist assumption that mental illness is strictly a matter of an aberrant brain, carefully examine the literature of possession, experiment to determine why exorcists and deliverance ministers often succeed where psychiatry fails, and develop a more complete inventory of techniques for healing the complete person.

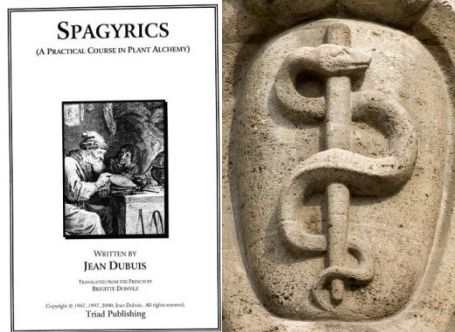

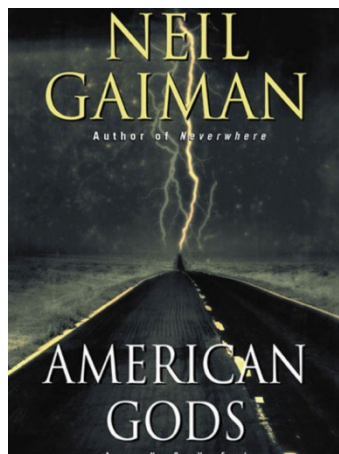

So much can be said about "American Gods", the story the characters and the symbolism prolific in the both the written media and the TV series, so much to explore. It has to be said that the original book is an incredible piece of storytelling and the TV series does an amazing job of capturing the spirit of it.

For this article it is the main theme of "American Gods" that I want to put forward. The essence is that man invents stories of religion and then through belief the Gods manifest into reality.

This concept has so many implications, but to me and experiences throughout my life, I now suspect that the following statement encapsulates my take on the situation.

What makes me say this? I have looked into the Norse religion, I am confident 100% that it is a hoax, the story was made up in 1795.

But my following testimony will give you a feeling for what I am postulating.

Part Eight - My Testimony

Twenty years ago my family went through a crisis, not the first and not the last but certainly the most profound. I have two younger brothers and they are twins but not identical. One of my brothers has walked a very dark path. It all started in his early teens. He was caught on a number of occasions causing a fracas in public after eating magic mushrooms.

The original Germanic god of war and the patron god of justice, the precursor of Odin. At the time of the Vikings, Tyr had to make way for Odin, who became the god of war himself. Tyr was by then regarded as Odin's son (or possibly of the giant Hymir). He is the boldest of the gods, who inspires courage and heroism in battle. Tyr is represented as a man with one hand, because his right hand was bitten off by the gigantic wolf Fenrir (in old-Norse, the wrist was called 'wolf-joint'). His attribute is a spear, the symbol of justice, as well as a weapon.

My brother visited or moved back to the Midlands for short periods of time. It was on one of these time periods back home that he met his future wife, a lovely blonde lady from Finland.

It had been almost five years since the death of my Mother and my brother leaving the church, at the time I suspected nothing, in fact any interactions I had with my brother were always usually fun. My brother was always the joker of the family, from a young age he was the loud annoying one. He then moved to Finland and got married, it was then that I started receiving phone calls in the middle of the night. The first time I received one of these late night calls was distressing to say the least. My brother would be screaming that demons were trying to get him, that he saw demons and other entities, they were pacing around outside and trying to get in

through the windows. Not only did he phone me in desperation but other times just to talk. He would tell me about what he had been doing with the Norse group in Blackpool and some of what he told me chilled me to the bone.

In a nutshell this Norse group truly believed that the Viking pantheon of Gods was a real thing. They discussed them, they worshipped them and they summoned them. The members of this group individually swore an oath to one of the Gods swearing to be their servant for the rest of their life. My brother described rituals that they would perform that ultimately would allow the Gods to use their bodies as vessels to allow communication and instruction.

My brother told me about the first ritual that he had attended where the self-professed leader of this group summoned the spirit of the All Father, Odin into his body. He described the ominous feeling of presence and change of atmosphere as Odin entered the host, the change in voice to a booming authoritative tone and that the spirit was so intense so powerful that the energy of this summoned spirit leaked out of the eyes of the more than willing participant in glowing tendrils of light.

Over the space of a few months my brother's hallucinations escalated, he was living in constant fear. He made the decision to approach a mental health hospital in Finland where he was admitted and treated, I never found out what he was given to quell the hallucinations at the time but assume it was some kind of antipsychotic drug. All went quiet and things seemed to have settled down, then out of the blue my brother declared that he and his wife were returning to the UK as the job situation in Finland was rather bleak for both of them.

It was after about twelve months of the return to England that my brother's behaviour was noticeably different. He and his wife had rented a ground floor flat not far from Birmingham City centre on a

busy main road. My brother had started to appear nervous when I met up with him occasionally at weekends, not with me but just his general mood. He did not mention at the time that he had started seeing things again. It was then that he started disappearing for unexplained hours, he told the family that he was going for walks. He also did not mention at the time that he was concerned and had approached a mental health hospital here in the UK for assistance, but unlike the facility in Finland this one turned him away.

What follows now is dark, gruesome and horrifying and I warn you that disturbing revelations will come from what I am about to tell you, where it leads may not be something you even want sitting in your mind. But for those that really want to know yet another truth of what is going on here in this realm, then I offer you a key to the door.

My brothers disappearances intensified until one day instead of a few hours he went missing for two days. His wife was out of her mind with worry and myself and my brothers twin were tasked with looking for him, we searched but to no avail.

It was the Police that brought him back home, he was found wandering in a park miles from his home, dishevelled, dirty and zombie like.

The next day my brother's wife had left early in the morning to go to work leaving my brother on his own in the flat. As I mentioned earlier this was a ground floor flat but this was not self contained. The flat was in a large old house where rooms were converted into flats throughout. Upstairs one of the flats was rented by a homosexual young man, I had actually bumped into him a few times, he was harmless and did not deserve what was about to happen to him, nobody deserves the horror that this poor guy was about to receive.

Sometime in the early afternoon my brother went up the stairs to this young man's flat, kicked the door in and proceeded to put his victim through at least two hours of horrendous torture. This culminated in this young man being hung by the neck on a rope, stabbed fifteen times with a carving knife and horrifically my brother scooped his one eye out with a metal spoon. I do not know how close it had come, but the young man survived this experience albeit scarred for life. If it was not for the intervention of the Police who had been alerted to the scene by screaming that the young man most definitely would not have lived another day.

The story only gets stranger from here on in. Four Police officers arrived at the scene, when they got upstairs they caught my brother with the knife in his hand stabbing the young man. They proceeded to tackle my brother, they will probably have nightmares for the remainder of their lives with what they faced that day. It is a good thing my brother discarded the knife when the Police went for him as they probably would all be dead. My brother screamed out that he was the, "Blood God" and he proceeded to take hold of the policemen and throw them around like rag dolls, lifting them above his head as though they were feather weight. They did not have a chance but one of them managed to call for back up. It took twelve police officers in total to bring down and restrain my brother that day. They remarked that it was like having to fend off Superman.

Myself and the twin had been alerted by my brother's wife of the incident and the twin was outside the flat when my brother was man handled and thrown into the back of a van. He was covered in blood from head to toe, the twin was concerned and thought that the Police may have harmed my brother, but the Policemen calmed the twin and told him that not one drop of the blood on my brother was his own. My brother was taken into custody and after processing

was put straight into Prison, it was around six months before he was to be trialled.

The Judges verdict was insanity, my brother was sent to a high security mental asylum (no other word describes it) he was diagnosed with schizophrenia. I never visited my brother while he was in prison, neither did his wife, in fact we never saw her again she went back to Finland that week and filed for divorce.

When my brother was moved to the mental facility I made regular visits to go and see him. We were allowed to meet him in a common room initially for our safety with many staff at hand. The first time I visited him was terrifying. He was obviously drugged up with masses of antipsychotic medication. But let me tell you, this was not my brother sitting before me, his face was contorted, he did not utter a single word his eyes were devoid of humanity. There was an overwhelming presence of something else, something not human.

Slowly over the course of around three months the presence diminished and my brother started communicating again. He was distraught, he suffered then and he still struggles now twenty years later with the horror of what he did to that young man.

My brother stayed in two mental institutions for seven years, he was then released into the community under a section maintained by the British Home Secretary under continual monitoring and medication.

Last year I sat in a court room with my brother and he was made a free man by a judge. To this day I am well aware that the thing my brother had let invade his mind had not been exorcised from him. Every now and then I feel it watching. This is why I went for medium training some years ago and believe me I have so much more to share. But for now, know this, there are powers at work in this world and they are certainly dark as hell.

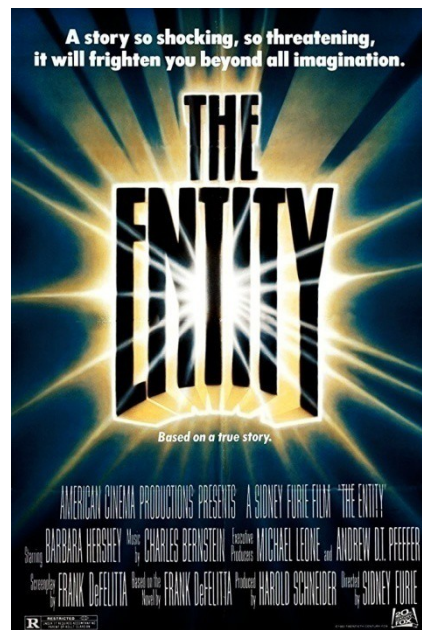

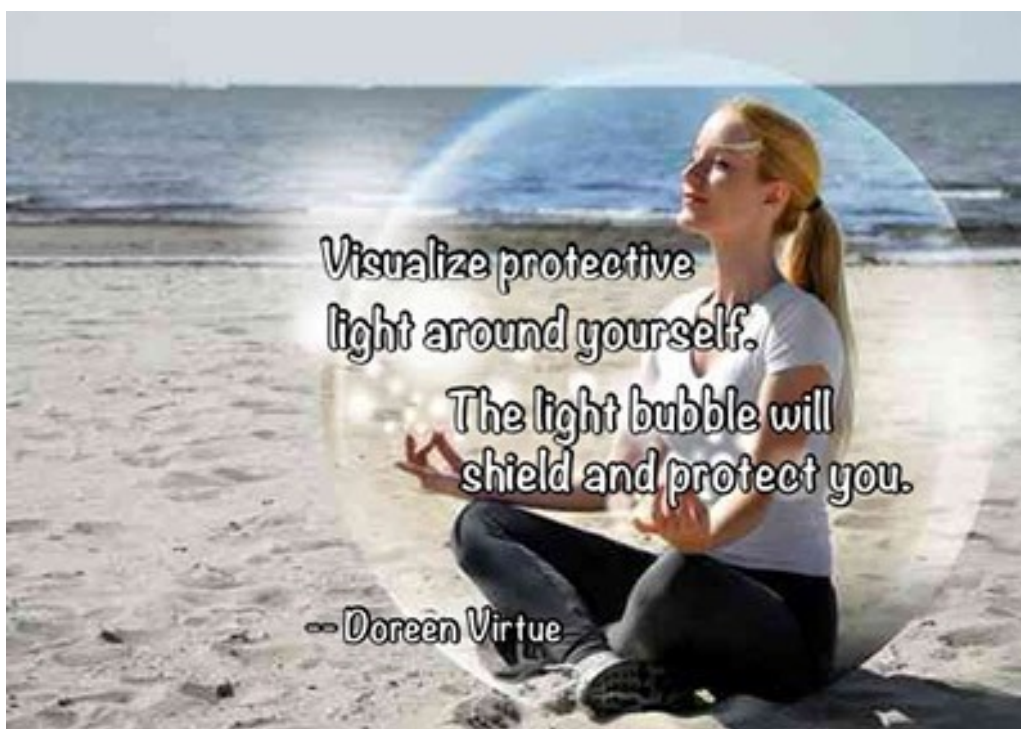

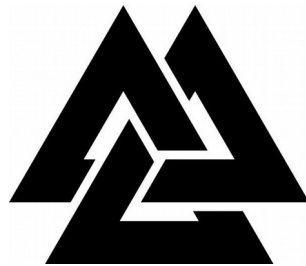

It is generally through personal experience that someone will throw away the programming, after witnessing something so profound with their own eyes it is then the illusion crumbles.

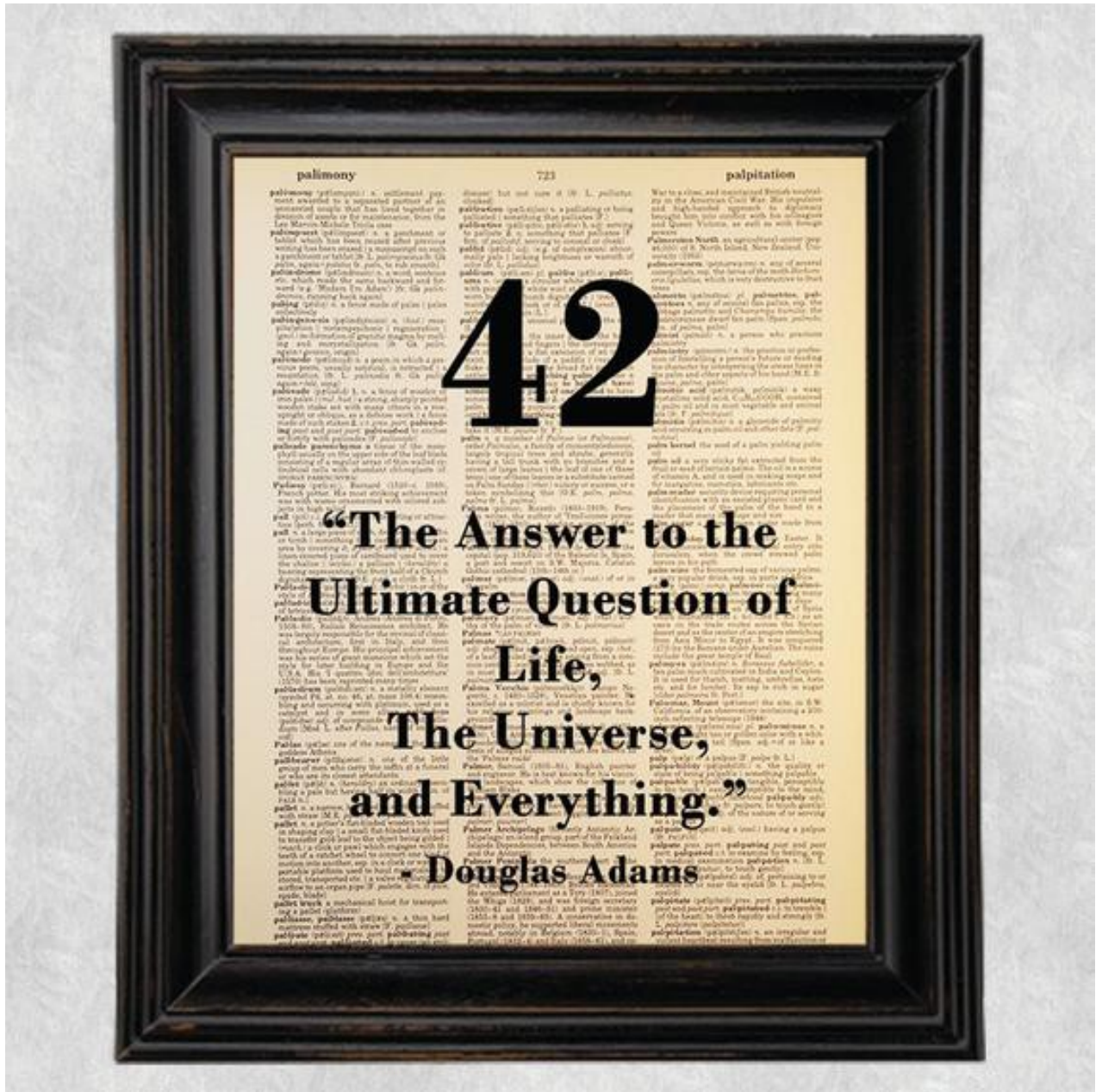
This reality is so unlike what we are taught, yet we can logically and systematically break down each component of deception, that much is now clear.
